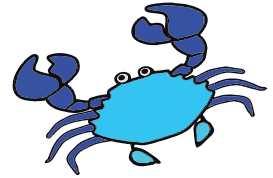

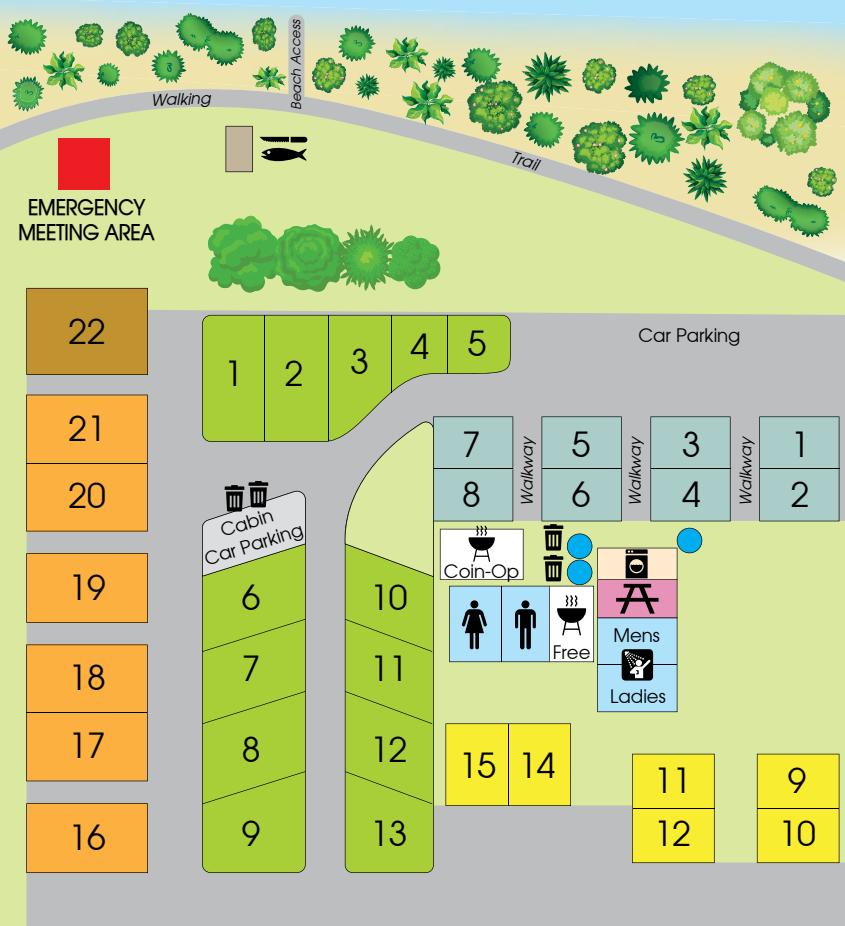

WELCOME TO PORT VINCENT CARAVAN PARK & SEASIDE CABINS

Please follow these rules and regulations in the interest, comfort and safety of all our guests.

Our Park Office is open from 2pm-5pm and Sunday 2pm-4pm.

Our office may be unattended at times due to cleaning and park duties. A bell is provided if unattended or phone for after hours enquiries or emergencies.

Check in time is after 2pm and check out time is before 10am

FEES - Any outstanding fees are payable in full on arrival. No refunds on tariffs if your stay is cut short.

CHECK IN/OUT - Please report to office on arrival. Check in time is after 2pm and check out time is before 10am.

Please re-book before 5pm the night before departure if intending to stay on.

ROAD RULE - Speed limit is 5kph at all times! (walking pace). Standard road rules and safety laws apply to everyone.

Bike skateboard riders must wear a helmet at all times.

VEHICLES - Parking of all vehicles is at the managers discretion. All vehicles must be parked on own site/carpark and not on other vacant sites/carparks. Management approval is required for extra vehicle and/or boat parking.

Extra Car/Boat parking area is available. NO Electric Vehicle Charging is allowed anywhere within the caravan park.

VISITORS - Visitor's must report to the office before entering the park and their cars are to be parked on the road outside the park. Visitors are required to leave the park by 10pm. Patrons are responsible for their visitor's behaviour and any fees due for overnight stays or use of showers.

CAR/BOAT WASHING - Car and boat washing is not permitted in the park.

CABINS - The number of people occupying any cabin must not exceed the number of beds provided.

Additional fees apply for additional people. All cabins are non-smoking.

SITES - One 15amp caravan power cord only per site. One car and caravan (with annex) or tent per site.

Please do not park or encroach onto other sites. Maximum of six persons per site.

Strictly no mats, flooring or tents allowed on the grassed beach side sites at any time.

AMENITIES - Cleaning times vary, but generally between 10am – 12 noon. Always use caution when wet floors are in evidence

RUBBISH - Secure in a tied bag prior to placing in the appropriately labelled rubbish bins. Bins are conveniently located around the park at four bin stations for disposal of general rubbish, recycling and refundable containers.

Bins are collected on a Tuesday morning. Do not put rubbish in bins without bin liners.

PETS - Are allowed at managers discretion, on powered sites and four pet friendly cabins ONLY!

Supervised, restrained, and clean up after. Pets must not disturb other patrons and are not to be left unattended.

CHILDREN - Children must always be supervised by an adult and accompanied to the amenities.

Baby's bath is located in one ladies/family shower.

FISH CLEANING - To be completed at the fish cleaning area only! (located at beachfront). Clean up and wash down after use. All fish and crab rubbish is to be bagged and disposed of in the red lidded garbage bins only.

BBQ'S/KITCHEN - Free BBQ's and camp kitchen is located adjacent to the amenity buildings.

Complete with coffee machine, ovens, sinks, kettle and toaster. Please clean up after use.

LAUNDRY - Coin operated washing machines (4 x \$1 and 1 x 20c). Dryer (\$1 for 5 minutes). Removal of clothes from machines/lines asap. Iron and ironing boards are available. Laundry powder is available to purchase from the park office.

NOISE Is to be kept to a minimum at all times, especially after 10pm. Noise which disturbs others after will not be tolerated.

FIRES - Open fires are not permitted in the caravan park at any time.

MANAGEMENT - Failure to observe rules may result in ejection from the park.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURE

Should a fire occur, the following actions should be undertaken

Assist anyone in immediate danger — Raise the alarm immediately — Telephone 000

Proceed immediately to the emergency assembly area

All cabins and the camp kitchen areas have fire extinguishers and fire blankets.

Please make sure you are totally aware of this procedure
